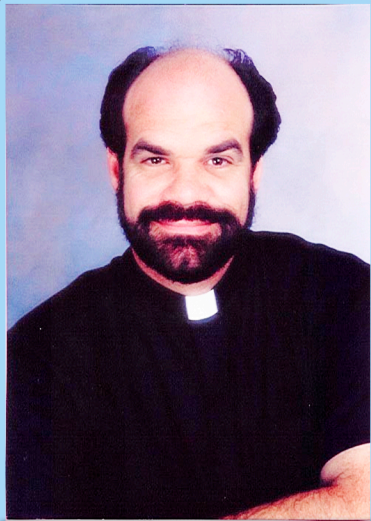

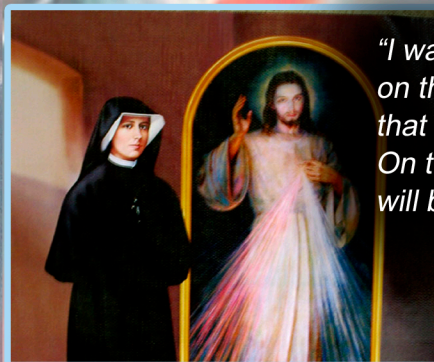

On April 27, 2014, Divine Mercy Sunday, Pope Francis canonized Saint John Paul II.
It was at the Canonization Mass for St. Faustina in April 2000, that then Pope John Paul II
proclaimed the Second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday, a feast day for the universal church.
He died on the very vigil day of this feast in 2005 and was beatified in May 2011 on the same feast.
